**1. Discussion and action on Ordinance 2026-3 of the Town of Dinosaur, Colorado, setting forth the compensation to be paid to the Mayor and Trustees of the Dinosaur Town Council.**

**2. Discussion and action on Resolution 2026-6 of the Town of Dinosaur formally completing the dissolution of the Moffat County Marketing District.**

Sherman Romney mentioned that a meeting was held regarding the dissolution of the Moffat County Marketing District. The district collected lodging/tourism tax revenue for economic development, and the tax expired after 10 years. The ballot to continue the district failed. Funds collected after the expiration date will be refunded to the businesses that collected the tax. The remaining funds will be distributed among Dinosaur, Craig, and Moffat County, with Moffat County serving as the fiscal agent.

A. Town Administrative / Infrastructure Updates

1. Emergency Services / IT Town utilizes Rangely 911 dispatch services. The lack of IT infrastructure in the Council Chambers was noted.
2. Water and Sewer System with ongoing sewer system issues due to aging infrastructure and design limitations. The major problem area is identified with the failing pipe and poor flow conditions. Maintenance includes jetting, camera inspections, and repairs. Funding opportunities and engineering solutions are being explored.
3. Water Rates / DOLA Requirements. Discussion held regarding compliance with the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA). Water and sewer rates will be reviewed for funding eligibility.

4. Regional Coordination (Rangely). Discussion held regarding Rangely water issues and potential collaboration opportunities.
