The meeting was called back to order at 9:11pm. **No action was taken.**

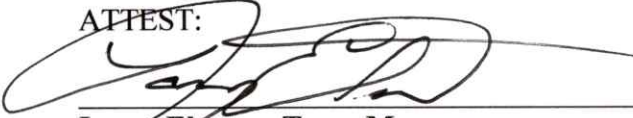
